Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Exempt Dangerous Drugs and Devices

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons is included in this rulemaking file. The information contained therein is complete and no changes have been made.

Local Mandate A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Business Impact

This regulation would not have significant adverse economic impact on businesses. It places in regulation a listing of drugs that originally was in statute. This change is intended to allow for a more timely amendment to the listing should additional drugs be deemed appropriate for exemption from Pharmacy Law requirements.

Consideration of Alternatives

No alternative which was considered would be either more effective as and less burdensome than the proposed regulation. The move to regulation was a statutory mandate.

Comment Received During the 45-Day Comment Period (August 25, 2000 to October 9, 2000)

Steven W. Gray, representing the Pharmacy Operations Division of the California Division of the Kaiser Permanente Medical Care Program (Kaiser), in a letter dated September 15, 2000, stated that Kaiser supports the board's proposal.
