Call to Order

Chairperson Stanley Weisser called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

Chairperson Weisser conducted a roll call. Committee members present: Victor Law and Stanley Weisser. Committee member Ricardo Sanchez was absent.

1. Review of Proposed Changes to Title 16 California Code of Regulations Section 1760 Disciplinary Guidelines

Ms. Sodergren explained that after the June committee meeting, staff had made changes to the disciplinary guidelines in order to incorporate the items discussed by the committee. She noted that items that had been edited after the June committee meeting were highlighted in green. A copy of the disciplinary guidelines, including the additional edits, are provided immediately following these minutes.

The committee thanked Ms. Sodergren for her work on the disciplinary guidelines.

Chairperson Weisser asked Mr. Law and Ms. Herold if they had any specific sections they would like to discuss. They responded that they did not have any questions on the changes.

Chairperson Weisser stated that as there were no questions or additional edits to the disciplinary guidelines the committee could approve the entire document at one time. Mr. Law agreed with the recommendation.

There were no comments from the public.

Committee Motion (Recommendation to the full board): Modify the Title 16 California Code of Regulations Section 1760 and the Disciplinary Guidelines (with the text in red removed), as proposed, which are incorporated by reference in that section. In addition, direct staff to take all steps necessary to initiate the formal rulemaking process; authorize the Executive Officer to make any non-substantive changes to the rulemaking package, and provide a 45-day public comment period.
