### Recent news:

- The Compounding Committee met Sept. 5 in Irvine and Sept. 24 in Sacramento.
- A committee of the board met Sept. 13 in Sacramento to hear petitions for reduction of disciplinary penalty pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4309, subdivision (c).
- About 110 pharmacists attended a full day of free CE training on drug abuse and drug diversion topics Sept. 17 at California Northstate University in Elk Grove.
