- → <u>Assembly Bill 1286</u> went into effect January 1, 2024, and it's designed to provide healthcare workers with additional support in their working environment to decrease medication errors.

The Board is actively researching data compiling companies that will register information from pharmacists. Medication error reporting will not begin until the Board approves such an entity.
