Granules Pharmaceuticals Inc. is recalling Metoprolol Succinate Extended-Release Tablets USP, 25 mg. The recall is initiated due to Metoprolol Succinate ER Tablets 25mg, batch number #1400008A (100-count), failed to meet dissolution acceptance criteria in the stability studies at the 6th month (25°C/60% RH) long-term. Consequently, batch number #1400008B (500-count), also manufactured from the same bulk batch #1400008. No adverse events have been received to-date for the product lot.

Metoprolol Succinate Extended-Release Tablets USP, 25 mg is a beta-blocker used to treat chest pain (angina), heart failure, and high blood pressure. Lowering high blood pressure helps prevent strokes, heart attacks, and kidney problems. It looks white to off white, oval shaped, film coated scored tablets, debossed with "I" and "25" on either side of score line on one side and score line on other side. Free from physical defects.
