IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the aboveentitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

### **PARTIES**

1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy (Board). She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Aspasia A. Papavassiliou, Deputy Attorney General.

#### FORMER RESPONDENTS

- 2. On or about April 16, 2015, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 53596 to Bacon East Pharmacy with Lisa K. Harb as the Owner. The permit expired due to a change in location on March 4, 2019, and was surrendered effective September 15, 2021, pursuant to a stipulated settlement in this matter.
- 3. On or about March 4, 2019, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57144 to Bacon East Pharmacy with Lisa K. Harb as the Owner. The permit was canceled due to a discontinuance of business on May 27, 2020, and was surrendered effective September 15, 2021, pursuant to a stipulated settlement in this matter.

#### **CURRENT RESPONDENTS**

- 4. On or about July 1, 2016, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 54552 to Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy (Respondent Reliable Rexall), with Sean Brian Weekes and William Mostyn Steel as the Owners, and Sean Brian Weekes as the pharmacist-in-charge (PIC). The permit was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on July 1, 2022, unless renewed.
- 5. On or about October 18, 2013, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacist License Number RPH 70114 to Sean Brian Weekes (Respondent Weekes). The Original Pharmacist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on July 31, 2023, unless renewed.
- 6. Respondents Reliable Rexall and Weekes are represented in this proceeding by attorney Jonathan G. Stein at 5050 Laguna Boulevard, Suite 112-325, Elk Grove, CA 95758.

**JURISDICTION** 

7. Accusation No. 7007 was filed before the Board, and is pending against Respondents Reliable Rexall and Weekes. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondents on February 5, 2021. Respondents timely filed their Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of the Accusation is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.

### ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 8. Respondent Weekes, individually and on behalf of Respondent Reliable Rexall, has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 7007. Respondent also has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order.
- 9. Respondents are fully aware of their legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right to present evidence and to testify on their own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 10. Respondents voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waive and give up each and every right set forth above.

### **CULPABILITY**

- 11. Respondents admit the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 7007, agree that cause exists for discipline, and hereby surrender their Original Pharmacy Permit No. PHY 54552 and Original Pharmacist License No. RPH 70114 for the Board's formal acceptance.
- 12. Respondent Weekes understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of his Original Pharmacy Permit and Original Pharmacist License without further process.

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#### **CONTINGENCY**

- 13. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board. Respondents understand and agree that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent or its counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondents understand and agree that they may not withdraw their agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 14. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 15. This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 16. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Original Pharmacy Permit No. PHY 54552, issued to Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy (Respondent Reliable Rexall), and Original Pharmacist License No. 70114, issued to Sean Brian Weekes (Respondent Weekes), are surrendered and accepted by the Board.

The surrender of Respondent Reliable Rexall's Original Pharmacy Permit and
 Respondent Weekes' Original Pharmacist License and the acceptance of the surrendered permit

and license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondents. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondents' license history with the Board. Respondents understand and agree that for purposes of Business and Professions Code section 4307, this surrender shall be construed the same as revocation.

- 2. Respondent Reliable Rexall shall lose all rights and privileges as a pharmacy in California, and Respondent Weekes shall lose all rights and privileges as a pharmacist in California, as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
- 3. Respondents shall cause to be delivered to the Board their pocket license and, if issued, their wall certificate, on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.
- 4. If Respondents ever apply for licensure or petition for reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a new application for licensure. Respondents must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in effect at the time the application or petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 7007 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondents when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the application or petition. Respondents are required to report their surrenders as a disciplinary action. For Respondent Weekes, the requirements include, but are not limited to, taking and passing the California Licensure Examination prior to the issuance of a new license.
- 5. Respondents shall not apply to the Board for licensure or petition for reinstatement for at least three (3) years after the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
- 6. Respondent Weekes shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the amount of \$19,306.25 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.
- 7. If Respondents should ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care licensing agency in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 7007 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondents for the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict licensure.

### **ACCEPTANCE**

BACON EAST PHARMACY; RELIABLE REXALL SUNSET PHARMACY; and SEAN BRIAN WEEKES ACCUSATION

#### **PARTIES**

- 1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs.
- 2. On or about April 16, 2015, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 53596 to Bacon East Pharmacy (Respondent Bacon East I), with Lisa K. Harb as the Owner. The permit expired due to a change in location on March 4, 2019, and has not been renewed.
- 3. On or about March 4, 2019, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57144 to Bacon East Pharmacy (Respondent Bacon East II), with Lisa K. Harb as the Owner. The permit was canceled due to a discontinuance of business on May 27, 2020, and remains canceled.
- 4. On or about July 1, 2016, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 54552 to Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy (Respondent Reliable Rexall Sunset), with Sean Brian Weekes and William Mostyn Steele as the Owners. The permit was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on July 1, 2021, unless renewed.
- 5. On or about October 18, 2013, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Pharmacist License Number RPH 70114 to Sean Brian Weekes (Respondent Weekes). The Original Pharmacist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on July 31, 2021, unless renewed.
- 6. Respondent Weekes was Pharmacist-in-Charge (PIC) of Respondent Bacon East I from April 16, 2015, to March 4, 2019, and of Bacon East II from March 4, 2019, to March 24, 2020. In addition, Respondent Weekes has been PIC of Respondent Reliable Rexall Sunset since July 1, 2016.

#### **JURISDICTION**

7. This Accusation is brought before the Board of Pharmacy (Board), Department of Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.

1	8. Section 4113, subdivision (c), of the Code states that the pharmacist-in-charge			
2	shall be responsible for a pharmacy's compliance with all state and federal laws and regulations			
3	pertaining to the practice of pharmacy.			
4	9. Section 4300.1 of the Code states:			
5	The expiration, cancellation, forfeiture, or suspension of a board-issued license			
6	by operation of law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, the placement of a license on a retired status, or the voluntary surrender of a license by a			
7	licensee shall not deprive the board of jurisdiction to commence or proceed with any investigation of, or action or disciplinary proceeding against, the licensee or to render			
8	a decision suspending or revoking the license.			
9	STATUTORY PROVISIONS			
10	10. Section 4301 of the Code states, in pertinent part:			
11	The board shall take action against any holder of a license who is guilty of			
12	unprofessional conduct or whose license has been issued by mistake. Unprofessional conduct shall include, but is not limited to, any of the following:

14	(j) The violation of any of the statutes of this state, of any other state, or of the			
15	United States regulating controlled substances and dangerous drugs.

17	(o) Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of or conspiring to violate any provision or term of this chapter or of the applicable federal and state laws and regulations governing pharmacy,			
18	including regulations established by the board or by any other state or federal regulatory agency.			
19	. 11. Section 4307 of the Code states:			
20	(a) Any person who has been denied a license or whose license has been			
21	revoked or is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was under suspension, or who has been a manager, administrator, owner, member,			
22	officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control of any partnership, corporation, trust, firm, or association whose application for a			
23	license has been denied or revoked, is under suspension or has been placed on probation, and while acting as the manager, administrator, owner, member, officer,			
24	director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the license was			
<ul><li>25</li><li>26</li></ul>	denied, revoked, suspended, or placed on probation, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or in any other position with management or control of a licensee as follows:			
27	(1) Where a probationary license is issued or where an existing license is placed			
28	on probation, this prohibition shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed five years.			

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- 23. A Board verification audit of acquisition and disposition records of Respondents Bacon East I and Bacon East II for the period of January 1, 2019, to March 18, 2020, failed to account for an overage of 244 tablets of buprenorphine/naloxone 8mg/2mg tablets. The audit also showed a shortage of the following drugs: 29 Invega Sustenna 234mg/1.5ml syringes; 16 Abilify Maintena 400mg syringes; 330 Truvada 200/300mg tablets; 9 Invega Sustenna 117mg/.75rnl syringes; 9 Abilify Maintena 300mg syringes; and 7 Invega Sustenna 78mg/0.5ml syringes. Respondents Bacon East I and Bacon East II purchased more of these drugs than they sold yet the drugs could not be found in the pharmacy inventory. The estimated loss of the missing drugs was \$155,561.87.
- 24. A subsequent Board audit of Respondent Reliable Rexall Sunset for the period from May 20, 2017, to May 20, 2020, revealed the loss of 270 buprenorphine/naloxone 8mg/2mg tablets but an overage of the following dangerous drugs: 60 Invega Sustenna 234mg/L5rnl syringes; 42 Abilify Maintena 400mg syringes; 4,105 Truvada 200/300mg tablets; 24 Invega Sustenna ll7mg/.75ml syringes; 19 Abilify Maintena 300mg syringes and 12 Invega Sustenna 78mg/0.5ml syringes.

### FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

### (Records of Dangerous Drugs; Maintenance of Records)

25. Respondents Bacon East I, Bacon East II, and Reliable Rexall Sunset have subjected their pharmacy permits to discipline and Respondent Weekes has subjected his pharmacist permit to discipline for unprofessional conduct under Code 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), in that they violated a law regarding dangerous drugs and a law or regulation regarding the practice of pharmacy. Specifically, Respondents violated section 4081, subdivision (a), and California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1718, regarding maintenance of records regarding dangerous drugs. As set forth in paragraphs 22-24, above, Respondents' records failed to account for a loss of dangerous drugs or the overage of other dangerous drugs.

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### SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

### (Operational Standards and Security)

26. Respondents Bacon East I, Bacon East II, and Reliable Rexall Sunset have subjected their pharmacy permits to discipline and Respondent Weekes has subjected his pharmacist license to discipline for unprofessional conduct under Code section 4301, subdivision (o), in that they violated a regulation regarding pharmacy practice. Specifically, Respondents violated California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1718, regarding operational standards and security. As set forth in paragraphs 22-24 above, Respondents failed to maintain the security of their dangerous drugs inventory.

### **DISCIPLINARY CONSIDERATIONS**

27. Complainant further alleges, as disciplinary considerations, that Respondent Bacon East I and Respondent Weekes were subject prior disciplinary and administrative actions, as described below.

### **Public Reprovals**

28. Effective July 13, 2017, following adoption of stipulated settlements in resolution of the Accusation in Case No. 5890, Respondent Bacon East I and Respondent Weekes were publicly reproved. The accusation alleged that a phenylephrine solution nasal spray compounded by Respondents on September 22, 2015, was contaminated with the bacteria *Serratia marcescens*, and that Respondents were subject to discipline for using expired ingredients, failing to maintain operational standards, and misbranding the compounded drug with a 180-day expiration date instead of a 30-day expiration date.

#### Citations

29. On or about April 3, 2018, the Board issued Citation No. CI 2016 74694 to Respondent Bacon East I and Citation No. CI 2017 7936 to Respondent Weekes. Those citations are final and alleged that from April 27, 2015, to November 10, 2015, Respondents' compounding logs were incomplete regarding three prescriptions for progesterone suppositories, in that the logs were missing manufacturer, lot, and expiration date for the polyethylene used to compound the drugs.

### OTHER MATTERS

- 30. Under Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit Numbers PHY 53596 or 57144 issued to Bacon East Pharmacy, then Bacon East Pharmacy shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for up to five years if the permit is placed on probation or until the permit is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 30. Under Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit Number 54552 issued to Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy, then Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for up to five years if the permit is placed on probation or until the permit is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 31. Under Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit Numbers PHY 53596 or 57144, issued to Bacon East Pharmacy, and Lisa K. Harb was an owner and had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the licensee was disciplined, then Lisa K. Harb shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for up to five years if the permit is placed on probation or until the permit is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 31. Under Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit Number 54552, issued to Respondent Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy, and William Mostyn Steel was an owner and had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the licensee was disciplined, then William Mostyn Steel shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for up to five years if the permit is placed on probation or until the permit is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 31. Under Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit Number 54522, issued to Respondent Reliable Rexall Sunset Pharmacy, and Sean Brian Weekes was an owner and had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the licensee was disciplined, then Sean Brian Weekes shall be prohibited from serving as a manager,

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
