4	1. Anne Sodergren ("Complainant") is the Executive Officer of the Board. She brought		
5	this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney		
6	General of the State of California, by Cristina Felix, Deputy Attorney General.		
7	2. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy is represented in this proceeding by attorney Herbert		
8	L. Weinberg, Esq., whose address is: 1990 South Bundy Drive, Suite 777, Los Angeles, CA		
9	90025.		
10	3. On or about February 3, 2020, the Board issued Permit Number PHY 57545 to		
11	Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. The Permit was in full force and effect at all times relevant to		
12	the charges brought herein and was set to expire on February 1, 2023, unless renewed. On		
13	October 31, 2022, the license was cancelled pursuant to a written request submitted by		
14	Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. Christine Amanda Gedjeyan ("Respondent Gedjeyan") was the		
15	pharmacist-in-charge of Respondent LA Care Pharmacy from February 3, 2020, until December		
16	27, 2021.		
17	JURISDICTION		
18	4. Accusation No. 7245 was filed before the Board, and is currently pending against		
19	Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents		
20	were properly served on Respondent LA Care Pharmacy on June 30, 2022. Respondent LA Care		
21	Pharmacy timely filed its Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of Accusation		
22	No. 7245 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.		
23	ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS		
24	5. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and		
25	understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 7245. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy		
26	also has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated		
27	Surrender of License and Order.

1	6. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy is fully aware of its legal rights in this matter,	
2	including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to	
3	confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right to present evidence and to	
4	testify on its own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of	
5	witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an	
6	adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act	
7	and other applicable laws.	
8	7. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and	
9	gives up each and every right set forth above.	
10	CULPABILITY	
11	8. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy understands that the charges and allegations in	
12	Accusation No. 7245, if proven at a hearing, constitute cause for imposing discipline upon its	
13	Permit.	
14	9. For the purpose of resolving the Accusation without the expense and uncertainty of	
15	further proceedings, Respondent LA Care Pharmacy agrees that, at a hearing, Complainant could	
16	establish a factual basis for the charges in the Accusation and that those charges constitute cause	
17	for discipline. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy hereby gives up its right to contest that cause for	
18	discipline exists based on those charges.	
19	10. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy understands that by signing this stipulation it enables	
20	the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of its Permit without further process.	
21	<u>CONTINGENCY</u>	
22	11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board. Respondent LA Care	
23	Pharmacy understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board may	
24	communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or	
25	participation by Respondent or its counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondent LA Care	
26	Pharmacy understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind the	
27	stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this	
28	stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of	
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	Stipulated Surrender of License Only as to LA Care Pharmacy, Inc., dba LA Care Pharmacy	

no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between 2 the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter. 3

12. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format ("PDF") and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

13. This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order is intended by the parties to be an 7 integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. 8 9 It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order 10 may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing 11 executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties. 12

14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that 13 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order: 14

ORDER 15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pharmacy Permit No. PHY 57545, issued to Respondent 16 LA Care Pharmacy, Inc., doing business as LA Care Pharmacy, Lilit Hakobyan, 100% 17 Shareholder, Chief Executive Officer, President, Secretary, Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer, 18 and Director, is surrendered and accepted by the Board. 19 1. The surrender of Respondent's Permit and the acceptance of the surrendered permit 20 by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. 21

This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent LA 22 Care Pharmacy's license history with the Board. Respondent understands and agrees that for 23 24 purposes of Business and Professions Code section 4307, this surrender shall be construed the same as revocation. 25

2. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy shall lose all rights and privileges as a pharmacy in 26 California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order. 27

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Respondent LA Care Pharmacy shall cause to be delivered to the Board its pocket
 license and, if one was issued, its wall certificate on or before the effective date of the Decision
 and Order.

4. If Respondent LA Care Pharmacy or Lilit Hakobyan ever applies for licensure or 4 5 petitions for reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a new application for licensure. They must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in 6 7 effect at the time the application or petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 7245 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent 8 9 LA Care Pharmacy and Lilit Hakobyan when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the application or petition. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy is required to report this surrender as 10 disciplinary action. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy may not apply for any license, permit, or 11 registration from the Board for three years from the effective date of this decision. 12

13 5. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and
14 enforcement in the amount of \$4,943 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

15 6. If Respondent LA Care Pharmacy or Lilit Hakobyan should ever apply or reapply for
16 a new license or certification, or petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care
17 licensing agency in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in
18 Accusation, No. 7245 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent LA Care
19 Pharmacy and Lilit Hakobyan for the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding
20 seeking to deny or restrict licensure.

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

18.	The Board received	a complaint from H	umana, an insuranc	e company, stating that

some of Humana's members denied requesting and/or receiving services from United Family
Pharmacy. The Board initiated an investigation into United Family Pharmacy. During that
investigation, the Board learned that Patient M. R. had received three creams labeled with Patient
M.R.'s name and prescriber Dr. J. F. Each of the three creams was dispensed by Respondent LA
Care Pharmacy. The patient did not expect or request the creams from LA Care Pharmacy. The
Board investigated Respondent LA Care Pharmacy's dispensing activity as part of the United
Family Pharmacy investigation.

20 A Board inspector inspected Respondent LA Care Pharmacy on July 15, 2021. The 19. 21 pharmacy was closed, but the inspector contacted Respondent Gedjeyan by phone, and 22 Respondent Gedjeyan met the inspector at the pharmacy. The inspector completed a general 23 inspection and reviewed the prescription books. She pulled the original faxed prescription and 24 prescription delivery receipt for Patient M. R. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy's records indicated 25 that in addition to the three creams Patient M. R. received, diclofenac 50 mg tab #60 was also 26 purportedly dispensed and delivered to Patient M. R. on April 14, 2021. Patient M. R. denied 27 receiving this medication.

20. The faxed prescription document for Patient M. R. contained a pre-printed, multiple 1 checkoff prescription form, with 26 different medications listed. Xanax, a controlled substance, 2 was one of the preprinted medications on the prescription form. The inspector also reviewed 3 Respondent LA Care Pharmacy's dispensing records for Dr. J. F., a prescriber at Clinicas Del 4 5 Valle ("CDV"),¹ who purportedly wrote the prescriptions for Patient M. R. 21. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy dispensed 971 prescriptions purportedly written by 6 Dr. J. F. between March 2021 and April 2021. Most of these prescriptions mirrored the 7 8 prescription for Patient M. R. Each fax looked identical, except for patient name, birthdate, and 9 date of the prescription. The origin of the faxes was not identified. The patients all resided in or 10 around Calexico, California, or El Centro, California, more than 200 miles from Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. All 971 prescriptions identified Dr. J. F.'s address as 120 W. Cole Road, 11 Calexico, California. However, that was not the correct address that Respondent LA Care 12 Pharmacy had on file for CDV or Dr. J. F.² 13 14 22. On August 4, 2021, the Board's inspector spoke to Dr. J. F. regarding the prescriptions attributed to her that were filled by Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. Dr. J. F. stated 15 that she never authorized any prescriptions for ketoconazole cream (podiatry related) or 16 diclofenac oral tablets. If a prescription form prescribed either of these medications, Dr. J. F. did 17 not authorize it. Dr. J. F. stated that after evaluating a patient, she started them on a topical 18 19 diclofenac (Volaren) gel, and sometimes betamethasone. Dr. J. F. stated she never checked more than two medications on a prescription form. She stated if there was a prescription form with 2021 more than two medications checked, it was done without her consent. Of the 971 prescriptions purportedly written by Dr. J. F. that Respondent LA Care Pharmacy dispensed between March 22 2021 and April 2021, Dr. J. F. did not authorize 247 prescriptions for Ketoconazole 2% cream 23 24 and 252 prescriptions for diclofenac 50 mg tablets. 23. The Board's inspector also observed several prescriptions purportedly written by 25 prescriber Dr. K. 4	24. While inspecting Respondent LA Care Pharmacy's prescription books, the Board's
5	inspector observed prescriptions written by Physicians Assistant R. A. from Uptimum Medical
6	Group ("UMG"). The prescriptions were signed by PA R. A., but dispensed and billed under Dr.
7	S. W. Some of the prescriptions had handwriting stating "verified # per MD," or change "to
8	Folixapure and verified # per MD," or words to that effect. Respondent Gedjeyan stated it was
9	her handwriting, and she would make the notations after verifying the prescriptions (or changes to
10	the prescriptions) with PA R. A. The prescriptions also appeared to be sent from "Restore
11	Health" not UMG. Ultimately, Dr. S. W. confirmed that he did not authorize 83 prescriptions
12	attributed to him and dispensed by Respondent LA Care Pharmacy. Dr. S. W. also confirmed that
13	no one at Respondent LA Care Pharmacy ever contacted him to discuss or verify the
14	prescriptions.
15	FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE
16	(Violation of Statutes: Furnishing Dangerous Drugs Without a Prescription
17	- Respondent LA Care Pharmacy)
18	25. Respondent LA Care Pharmacy's pharmacy permit is subject to disciplinary action
