## **Board Meeting Actions – April 29-30, 2021**

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions during a meeting April 29-30, 2021:

- Elected new Board officers for terms beginning June 1, 2021: Dr. Seung Oh, president; Dr. Maria Serpa, vice president; and Jignesh "Jig" Patel, treasurer.
- Updated the responsibilities of Board president and vice president to include duties delegated by the Board.
- Voted to develop a policy statement regarding academic misconduct and codes of conduct.
- Voted to approve an audit of the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE) and, if appropriate, transition to MPJE from California Practice Standards and Jurisprudence Examination (CPJE).
- Voted to expand the Board's current policy and statutory proposal regarding authority for pharmacists to order and perform tests to include authority for all CLIA-waived tests and to make permanent the provisions related to specimen collection.
- Approved changes to a draft pharmacy workforce survey regarding medication errors.
- Approved update to Board-provided training program related to furnishing HIV preexposure and postexposure prophylaxis (PrEP and PEP).
- Voted to enter the FDA Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Interstate
  Distribution of Compounded Drug Products provided sufficient resources and statutory changes are secured.
