## **Board Meeting Actions – October 27-28, 2021**

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions October 27-28, 2021:

- Adopted a policy statement providing guidance to licensees regarding proposed revisions to USP General Chapters 795 and 797.
- Approved pursuing a training and testing program for proposed pharmacists-in-charge (PICs).
- Approved convening a series of virtual listening sessions for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians in preparation for a Board summit on pharmacy technicians.
- Voted to initiate rulemaking to amend California Code of Regulations, Division 7, Title 16, section 1707.6, Notice to Consumers, including changes to wording under "Know Your Rights" and wording related to the name of a medication and its purpose; and to delegate to the executive officer authority to make nonsubstantive changes.
- Voted to adopt regulation language for California Code of Regulations, Division 7, Title 16, section 1704, Address Change Notification; and to delegate to the executive officer to make technical or nonsubstantive changes as may be required by control agencies to complete the rulemaking file.
