

## Board Meeting Actions – July 27-28, 2022

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions July 27-28, 2022:

- Approved minutes for Board meetings held April 26-27, 2022; May 11, 2022; and June 16, 2022.
- Reviewed the strategic objectives of the Board’s Strategic Plan.
- Received a report from the Organizational Development Committee.
- Voted to update the Board’s policy related to legislative positions by delegating power to the president to take Board positions on legislative bills between Board meetings.
- Reviewed a summary of work from the June 22, 2022, Standard of Care Committee meeting.
- Reviewed a summary of work from the June 22, 2022, Medication Error Reduction and Workforce Committee meeting
- Reviewed a summary of work from the July 19, 2022, Communication and Public Education Committee meeting.
- Reviewed a summary of work from the July 18, 2022, Licensing Committee meeting.
- Voted to initiate rulemaking to add Title 16, California Code of Regulations (CCR), section 1706.6, Temporary Licenses for Military Spouses/Domestic Partners.
- Reviewed a summary of work from the July 19, 2022, Enforcement and Compounding Committee meeting.
- Voted to incorporate additional changes to proposed amendments to Title 16, CCR section 1715.1, to clarify the self-assessment requirement for unlicensed automated unit-dose delivery systems (AUDS), to include gender-neutral language, and to change “vendor” to “manufacturer.”
- Voted to approve revisions to FAQs related to automated drug delivery systems (ADDS) with the exception of question No. 13, which will be returned for discussion and consideration by the Enforcement and Compounding Committee.
- Received a presentation on the Pharmacist Recovery Program.
- Voted to modify language to CCR section 1793.6(c)(2) and notice the modified text for a 15-day comment period and, if no adverse comments are received, authorize the executive officer to take steps necessary to adopt proposed regulations sections 1793.5, 1793.6, and 1793.65 and to complete the rulemaking.
- Reviewed a summary of work from the July 18, 2022, Legislation and Regulation Committee.
- Voted positions on the following legislation:
  - Assembly Bill 852: Support.
  - Senate Bill 872: Support.
  - Senate Bill 1259: Support.

- Received a report from the Executive Officer.
- Heard petitions for license reinstatement or early termination/other modification of penalty.
