The new fiscal year began July 1, 2025. The Board's estimated authorized expenditure is projected to be \$35,209,000, which is about a 1.47% increase from last year's authorized budget.

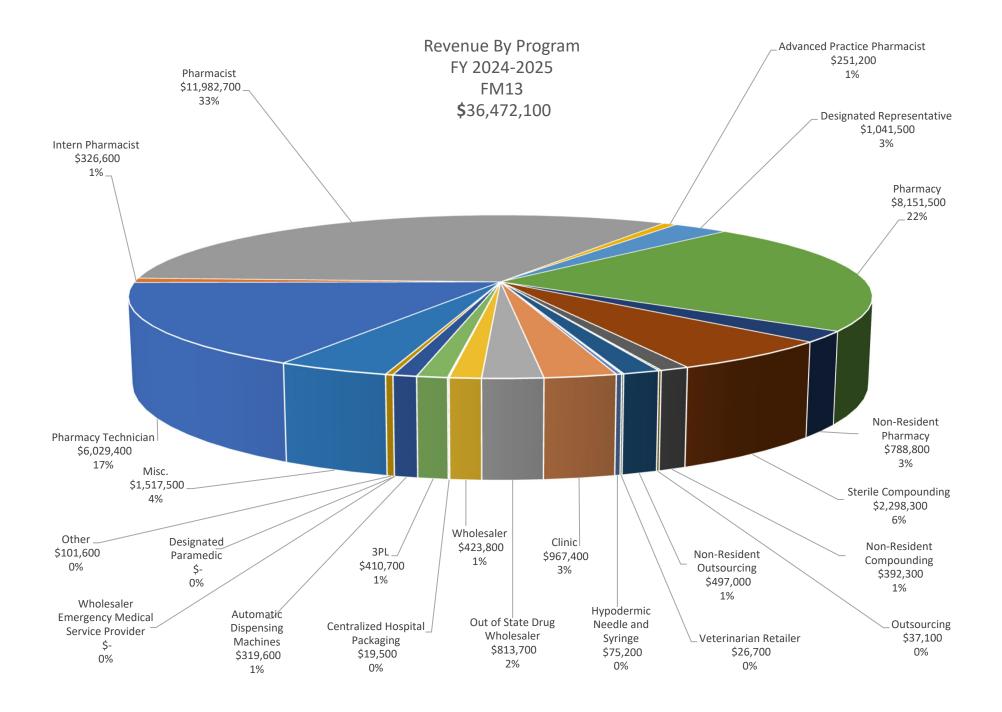

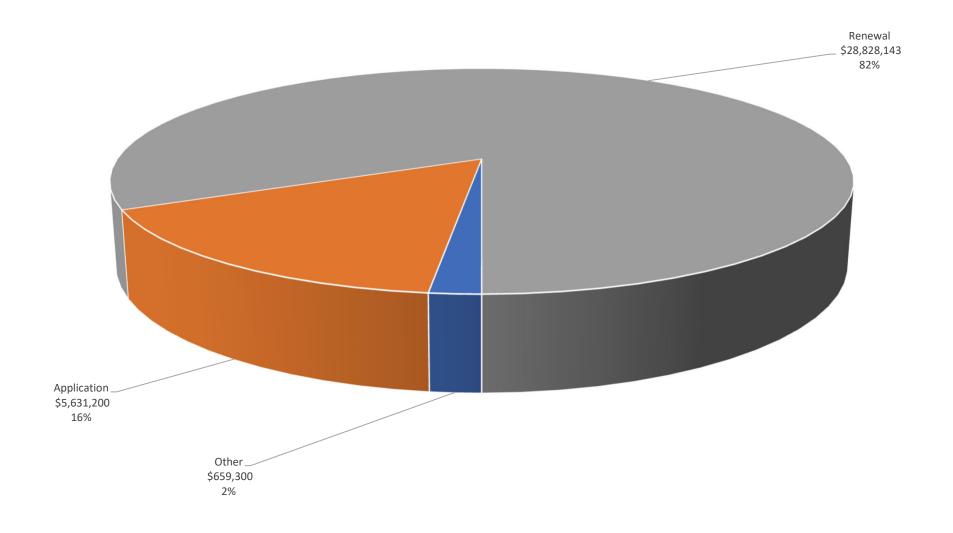




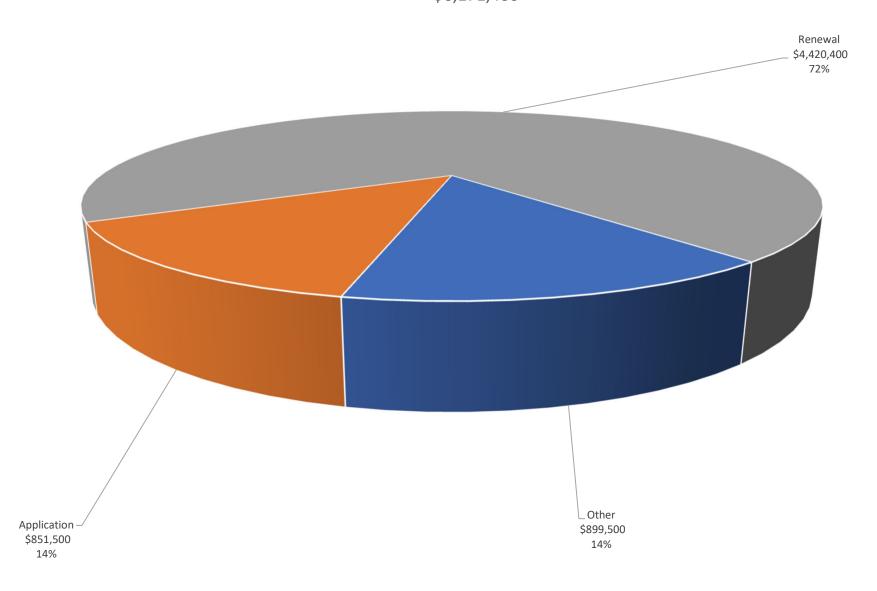


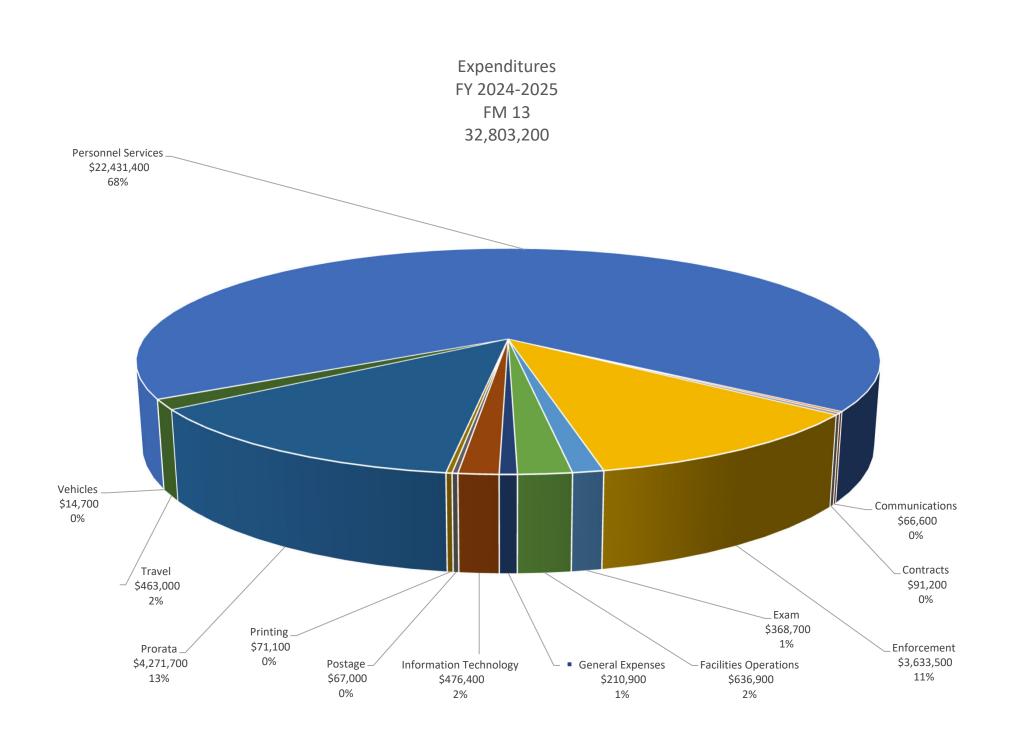


Apps vs Renewals FY 2024-2025 FM 13 \$35,118,600
